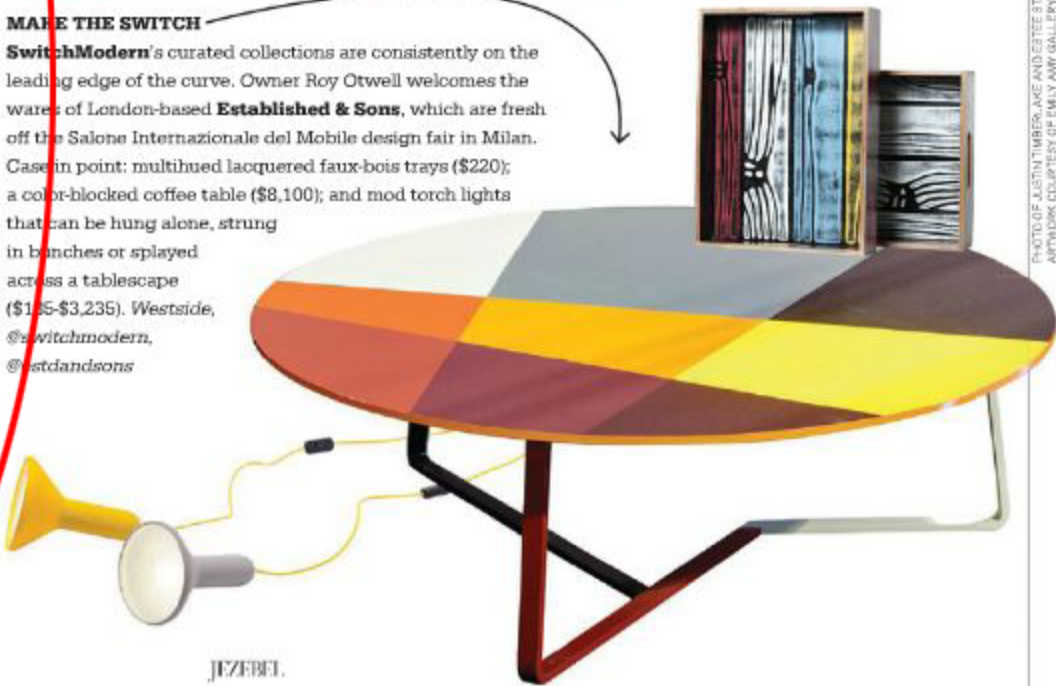


#### AN IDEA THAT FLOATS
